



Milton Keynes tennis enjoyed a very special visit from international tennis coach, Keith Reynolds, on Sunday 7th and Monday 8th March.

Keith was educated at Millfield School, Somerset where he had gained a tennis and football scholarship and Downing College Cambridge where he graduated with a Degree in Economics and played tennis and football for the University.

Keith's visit to Milton Keynes was organised by Tennis Works, who are heavily involved in tennis education and support. On the Sunday, selected local juniors from the Cavill Academy and David Lloyd endure a 3 hour coaching clinic and discovered the requirements to be a great tennis player. On the Monday, Keith delivered a workshop to 15 coaches, helping them to evaluate their way of coaching and how they can empower their players to make better decisions.
